Overview of the Dublin tour:

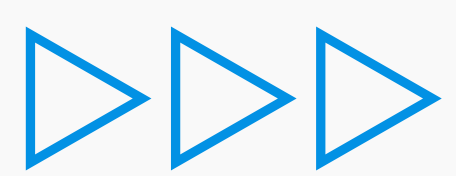
Your tour will start from the Spire in O'Connell Street and will cross the Ha'penny Bridge before going through Temple Bar, where we will view the pub of the same name, and visit the Project Arts Centre, where rock group U2 was discovered by talent scout Paul McGuinness in 1978. We then walk up the famous Fishamble Street, where Handel's Messiah was premiered in 1742, and later call at the controversial Molly Malone Statue. We view the majestic City Hall – an eloquent testimony to Dublin's built heritage. We pass through the city's largest and finest Georgian Residence – Powerscourt Townhouse – built in the manner of a Florentine Palazzo, now a bustling retro-chic shopping mall. We stroll through the famous St Stephen's Green before turning left onto Kildare Street to view the present-day Irish Parliament – before finally concluding the tour at the elegant Mansion House – home to Dublin's Lord Mayor and the first dedicated mayoral residence in Western Europe.

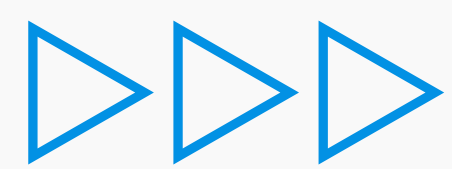

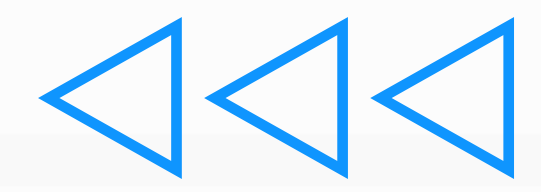

In-person or virtual presenters will have 13 minutes for paper presentation, and then 2 minutes for Q&A.

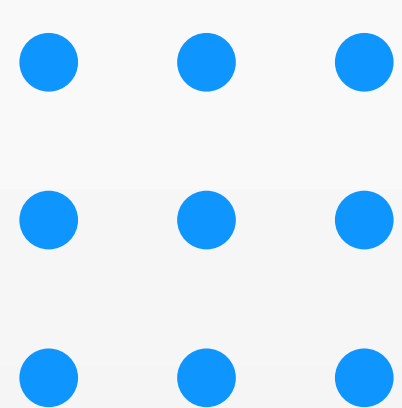
